Kim Fitzgerald reported on Family Fun Day progress. She has set up a budget (which is in the negative) & passed out copies to some of the committee members. She has spoken with members of the community and has obtained several ideas/expectations for the event. Cole gave an update on equipment purchases. The flags and scoreboard cost \$207.40. Flag football games have already started. Equipment check-out procedures need to be determined. Ron has ordered the tetherball and is removing the shed from Burkett Park. Volley ball sites at Warfield will be pursued with Brad Rees. Other items may be purchased if funds are available.

Susan handed out copies of the draft contract for Kim Fitzgerald that Dennis Hoover has reviewed.
