MINUTES FOR PARKS & EVENTS MEETING  
June 16, 2009

Call to order by Co-chair, Susan Dolan

Minutes for the May 2009 meeting were approved.

Susan welcomed Katy Johnson as the Committee's newest member. Katy reported on the number of volunteers she has signed up for Family Fun Day. It was felt that there will probably be sufficient volunteers (including committee members), but Katy will contact a few more sources in case of cancellations. Also, we will post a notice for volunteers on Channel 23.

Billy presented a slide show of safety/maintenance issues found at several of the Town's parks. He will meet with Ron Esworthy to discuss the summary of the issues. Irma reported that Jones Park will be updated with a Grant from the State.

Cole reported on the Kickball Tourney on Memorial Day. The net income would have been 35.26, but it was agreed that one team would receive a refund since they cancelled and the registration form did not state that the fee was non-refundable. Therefore, the final net loss was \$14.74.

There was a review of the year to date status of Parks & Events revenues and expenses. Chris True pointed out that the net income from the Golf Tourney was to be divided between Parks & Events and Century High School. Irma will make out a payment order so a check can be issued to Century for \$491.46. This means that the committee finished the year with a net loss of about \$416.

Susan gave a brief report on Kim Fitzgerald's progress on Family Fun Day. She has signed up several vendors and has received sponsorship donations from several others. It was noted what a good job she has done on this event and how much work has been involved so far.
