

# Snow Emergency Routes

All members of our community need to be aware of the **snow emergency routes** within our town. During a declared **snow emergency** there is no parking on these designated routes. Parking on these routes is both a violation of State Law, as well as Town Ordinance No.140-5. The Sykesville Police Department will be enforcing these laws during a **snow emergency**. These laws allow for the removal of the violating vehicle at the owners expense. It also allows for the issuing of a Town Citation with fines ranging from a minimum of \$100.00 to \$500.00. As you can see these violations carry serious consequences. We are providing the community with a list of our **snow emergency routes**, they are:

## Ordinance No. 140-5

Designation of snow emergency routes:

Second Avenue from Oklahoma Road to intersection at Spout Hill Road  
O'Brecht Road  
Spout Hill Road  
Third Avenue  
Springfield Avenue (Route 851)  
Main Street  
Jennifer Way  
Oklahoma Avenue and  
Norris Avenue

It is the policy of the Sykesville Police Department to enforce the **snow emergency** violations as follows:

- Any motor vehicle found to be in violation **will be issued a citation. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Any motor vehicle found to be blocking traffic will be towed and owner given a citation.
- First offense (class B violation) parked in violation. Town Citation \$100.00 fine, owner must remove vehicle.
- Second offense (class C violation) parked in violation. Town Citation, owner must remove vehicle. A fine of \$250.00
- All subsequent violations (class D violation) parked in violation. Town citation vehicle will be towed at owner's expense. A fine of \$500.00.

Please take time to notice the location of our **snow emergency routes** and plan accordingly. Your cooperation goes along way in making for a safer community.
